- Boots, breeches and ASTM helmets required for all riders.
- All tests are 2023 and are available online www.usef.org & <a href="www.usef.org & <a href="www.usef.org & <a href="www
 - Introductory through Training Level Test 2 will be ridden in a 20m x 40m arena
 - Training Level Test 3 & above will be in 20m x 60m arena.
 - Indoor and outdoor arenas may be used depending on how many entries we receive.
- Six ribbons per class. Junior and Senior riders placed separately. High Score Jr. & Sr. Awards.
- WNYDA High Score & Reserve Awards for series at the end of the season for active members!
- Offering USEA & Western Dressage test opportunities! Just specify which 2022 USEA or WDAA Test you would like to ride.
 - USEA & WDAA tests not going towards WNYDA awards.
 - WNYDA non-member fee not needed for those just riding USEA or WDAA tests

Show Fees:

- Test Fee: \$20/test *\$25/test for late entries post-marked after April 19th, late entries <u>may not</u> be accepted if space does not permit.
- Stabling: Limited number of stalls available, must contact equestrian@houghton.edu to reserve a stall.
 - \$35 for the day or \$60 for Friday overnight arrival.
 - Shavings are not provided and must be brought to put into stalls. Limited shavings are available to purchase for \$12/bag.
- Non-WNYDA Member-\$15 non-member fee (separate check made out to WNYDA)
 - Become a WNYDA member for no extra fees at future Challenge Series shows this year (www.wnyda.org)

Arrival & Riding Warm-Up:

Show Day Arrivals are not to arrive before 7:00am on show day. All those pre-approved for stabling Friday Overnight are not to arrive before 5:00pm.

- -Friday Evening-Competition Arena/s available for warm-up for those stabling overnight until 7:30pm
- -Saturday Show Day-7:00am-end of show Warm-Up Arena/s available

Important Facility/Show Guidelines:

- Dogs are allowed on the competition grounds but must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained.
- Alcohol, smoking & vaping are not allowed on the premises. Violators will be asked to leave.
- Competition arenas will be in the large Indoor & outdoor ring. Warm up will be in the Small indoor and back outdoor ring.
- In the event of tie scores between riders, the one with higher collective remarks will be placed better
