Western Pleasure Working Pairs-Contestants compete as a pair. Pairs are judged on uniformity of manners, paces, and ability to work together happily as a pair. Not split into age category.

Important Facility/Show Guidelines:

- Show apparel is not required. Feel free to dress up in fun fall attire. Helmets are required for all riders.
- All patterns will be posted in show office on show day.
- Schooling over trail obstacles or through patterns is not available on show day or Friday evening for overnight stabling.
- Horses should have proper western tack (western saddle with snaffle or curb bridle) for classes 1-21
 - English tack will be allowed for Trails, Games, and Speed Classes
- Dogs that are well behaved are allowed on the competition grounds but must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained.
- Alcohol, smoking & vaping are not allowed on the premises. Violators will be asked to leave.
- Concessions available on site for purchase.

Show Costs:

- Class Fees: \$10 per class or \$50 for the day per horse/rider pair
 - Stakes classes are an additional \$5 per class
- Stabling: Limited number of stalls available, must contact equestrian@houghton.edu to reserve a stall for \$35 for the day or \$60 for overnight. Shavings are not provided but must be brought & put into stalls. Limited shavings are available for purchase on site for \$12/bag.
- Checks & Cash are accepted as payment and can be brought upon arrival with registration. No electronic payment options are accepted.
